Notice of Race

- 1. RULES: The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-2016, and the prescriptions of US Sailing, the Procedural Rules (PR) for Interscholastic Competition 2013-2016 and the Sailing Instructions.
- FORMAT: Two Divisions (two skippers, two crews, plus substitutes) per school; twenty teams; a single round robin will be attempted and a boat rotation will be posted prior to the competitors meeting.
- 3. BOATS: Z420's and FJ's as supplied by the U.S. Coast Guard Academy. An attempt will be made, at the discretion of the Host, to switch Divisions and fleets at or approximately half way through the regatta. In the event of bad weather and at the discretion of the Host, both divisions may be sailed in Z420's.
- 4. REPORT TIME: 0830 on Sunday May 3, 2015. Competitors meeting NLT 0930.
- 5. LAST RACE: No race will be started after 1600 on Sunday May 3, 2015.
- HOUSING and MEALS: Will be the sole responsibility of each team. Please bring lunch materials with you since teams will not leave the Academy grounds during racing hours.
- 7. PARKING: Teams vehicles may be parked on Eagle Drive or in the Pine Hall parking lot. Each vehicle may be required to show license and registration. In addition, all competitors should be prepared to show a valid photo ID to the security officer at the front gate. Failure to provide proper identification could prevent access to the Academy.
- 8. **ELIGIBILITY: ISSA Member Teams must meet the eligibility requirements of the Interscholastic Sailing Association.**
- 9. BERTHS: Teams apply for berths to the organizers. Berths will be filled by the organizers in accordance with the following: 20 spots reserved for CT Schools until April 3rd.
