NOTICE OF RACE

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY: South Atlantic Interscholastic Sailing Association in conjunction with Golden Isles Community Sailing Center

SITE: Brunswick Landing Marina, 1701 Newcastle St, Brunswick, GA 31520

1. RULES:

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the SAISA Supplemental Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. In the event of a conflict between the governing documents and the Sailing Instructions the latter shall take precedence.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1. Competing schools must be current members of ISSA and SAISA and meet eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules, and Supplemental Rules.
- 2.2. Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school. The team leader must have the authority to authorize medical care for all sailors on the team.
- 2.3. Registration is on a first paid/first allowed basis. The regatta is limited to 12 teams. Registration will be confirmed via email, or phone, if email is not available.
- 2.4. Composite teams and Junior Varsity team may be permitted to register at the Host's discretion.

3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS:

3.1. Eligible schools and sailors must enter by submitting an official entry form (attached) to the regatta chairperson by Wednesday, November 14. Please also submit two separate checks, one for entry fee, and one for boat damage deposit, either with the entry form or hand delivered at the event. Send all forms and checks to: GICSC, 347 Major Wright Road, St. Simons Island, GA 31522. Please make checks payable to GICSC.

4. ENTRY FEE:

- 4.1. The entry is \$50 per school.
- 4.2. Make checks payable to: GICSC (Golden Isles Community Sailing Center)
- 4.3. Lunch will be available, \$5 per person at the event.

5. DAMAGE DEPOSIT:

- 5.1. A damage deposit of \$75 must be submitted with each entry. This is refundable if the boat and gear are returned undamaged. In the event damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided evenly amongst all the competing teams.
- 5.2. Make checks payable to: GICSC

6. BOATS:

6.1 The host will provide twelve 420 Sailboats and sails.

7. SCHEDULE:

Saturday, Nov 17

0830 Check in/registration/rigging 0900 Skippers' meeting 0930 First warning and schedule for the day

- 7.1 No alternate day due to weather or unforeseen conditions has been set.
- 7.2. Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board located at check-in area.

8. RACING AREA:

8.1. All races will be sailed in the East Brunswick River.

9. COURSES:

9.1. Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses as prescribed in ISSA PR 7.7.

10. SCORING:

10.1. The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules. Scores will be posted in real time through TechScore.

11. HOUSING:

11.1. Housing is not provided.

12. TRAVEL:

12.1. I-95, Exit 36A onto 341 South (eastbound). After 4.5 miles, turn right into the Brunswick Landing Marina Parking area. **Parking along the waterfront is reserved for slip owners**. Registration will be at Dock #1.

13. COACHING:

13.1. Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area during racing unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chairperson.

14. OFFICIAL NOTICE:

14.1. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, marijuana or any other controlled substance, as defined in 21 U.S. Code 802, the possession of which is unlawful under U.S. Code 841, or alcoholic beverages (distilled spirits, wine, and beer, each as defined in Chapter 51of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use). An alleged breach of this procedural rule shall not be grounds for a protest. However, when a report is received from any source, alleging such a breach a protest committee consisting of the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA Board of Directors, and the chairperson of the protest committee, shall follow the process described in RRS 69.1(c). If a hearing under RRS 69 is held, a competitor found to have breached this procedural rule shall be excluded from the remaining races of the series and, where practical, be removed from the regatta venues and sent home. Additional penalties consistent with RRS 69.2 may be imposed on the competitor or the competitor's team. This regulation is in effect during the entire event from the date and time of arrival through the date and time of departure from the regatta site.

15. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS:

15.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

16. WAIVER OF LIABILITY:

- 16.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 16.2. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
