



NOTICE OF RACE

SAISA North Point #2 October 19-20, 2019

HOST HIGH SCHOOLS: LAKE NORMAN HIGH SCHOOL & PINE LAKE PREP

1. RULES

This regatta will be governed by the current ISSA Procedural Rules ("ISSA PR"), SAISA Supplemental Rules ("SAISA SR"), and the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing ("RRS")*.

2. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- Saturday October 19, 2019
- 1100 Arrival, check-in and boat rigging
- 1145 Competitors' meeting
- 1230 First warning signal
- Sunday October 20, 2019
- 0800 Arrival and boat rigging
- 0930 First warning signal
- 1500 No A division races after

3. FORMAT

This will be a two-division regatta. Teams will rotate per a rotation chart distributed at the Competitor's Meeting. Competitors should expect numerous short races. It will be the goal of the Race Committee to complete at least one full rotation. Three races in each division must be completed to constitute a regatta.

4. SCORING

- 4.1 Races will be scored using the Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A as modified by ISSA PR 9.
- 4.2 Ties will be resolved as outlined in ISSA PR 11(c).
- 4.2 Protest hearings, if any, may take place between races.

5. TROPHIES

Prizes will be awarded as soon as possible after the last race sailed in the event.

6. ELIGIBILITY

- 6.1 All 2019-2020 member schools of SAISA North are eligible. Any SAISA teams may participate depending upon boat availability. All teams must be members in good standing with SAISA.
- 6.2 If a school wishes to participate, and has not yet paid ISSA/SAISA dues, they will be provided the opportunity to pay dues at check-in.
- 6.3 Registration will be accepted first from North teams whose registration package is received by October 15, 2019. Registration from other areas will then be accepted. Registration is on a first paid/first allowed basis.
- 6.4 Split teams, composite teams, and Junior Varsity teams are permitted to register per SAISA Supplemental Rules. Such Teams will not be scored officially for the regatta and the SAISA League Series in accordance with the Supplemental Rules. JV/Composite teams will be unofficially scored and posted online during regatta so teams can see how they are doing against the varsity teams.
- 6.5 An adult school representative/advisor is required to accompany each team and be responsible for the conduct on and off the water. The team representative, who may be an advisor, coach, or parent, is expected to have full authority to obtain medical treatment for his team members.

7. FEES & REGISTRATION

The entry fee shall be **\$60 per team**, paid in advance by using the registration and waiver forms below. Checks, registration forms and waivers are to be mailed to: **Michelle Hartman 127 E Cold Hollow Farms Drive, Mooresville, NC 28117**. Registrations will be accepted first from North Area teams in the order they are received. Registrations from other areas will then be accepted in the order received. Once 12 schools have registered, entry shall be contingent upon their ability to bring their own 420 boat in good condition to add to the rotation.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions, Course Diagrams and Rotation Charts will be available at the competitor's meeting at Lake Norman Yacht Club.

9. BOATS

- 9.1 Club 420's will be used. Twelve (12) will be provided by Lake Norman Yacht Club. Boats will be assigned in the order Registration Packages are received.
- 9.2 Teams which register after boats have been allocated will be required to provide a 420 boat and sails of comparable condition with sail numbers that do not duplicate the other boats which will be entered into the rotation. Note that, per supplemental rule 4.5, boats will be assigned first to full varsity teams, then to split varsity teams, composite teams, and JV teams, respectively.

10. RACING AREA

Racing will be on Lake Norman near Lake Norman Yacht Club <u>www.lakenormanyachtclub.com</u>, 297 Yacht Road, Mooresville, NC 28117

11. DAMAGE

Damage that requires beyond normal maintenance is considered a serious incident. If the Protest Committee determines that reasonable care was not used and resulted in damage, one or both boats may be disqualified, regardless of any alternative penalties already taken. In extreme cases, either or both boats may be excluded from the rest of the regatta and sailors or teams held financially responsible.

12. LUNCHES

Lunches will be available on both days for \$5 per lunch (sandwich, chip and drinks). Send lunch questions and orders to Ginger Missert at <u>gmissert@hotmail.com</u> no later than Tuesday October 15, 2019.

13. DIRECTIONS
