**Notice of Race (NOR)**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The ISSA Procedural Rules 2021-2024 available at <https://hssailing.org/documents/ISSA-PR-2021-2024.pdf> apply.
- 1.3 The MISSA Supplemental Rules available at <https://missa.hssailing.org/about/missa-district-rules> apply.

**2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 1200 Wednesday, October 6, 2021, on each regatta's respective Techscore webpage.

**3 COMMUNICATION**

- 3.1 The official notice boards for each event are located at <https://scores.hssailing.org>
- 3.2 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors & coaches on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.

**4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 4.1 Great Lakes Qualifier: This event is a MISSA Tier 2 regatta, open to all MISSA West team. Only one team per school may enter.

Dusty Waters Regatta: This event is a MISSA Tier 3 regatta, open to 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades from mixed schools.

- 4.2 Boats may enter the event by emailing Emlie Veinot, [sailplss@gmail.com](mailto:sailplss@gmail.com) with your intent to participate. Teams should indicate their interest for the Great Lakes Qualifier (Tier 2) or the Dusty Waters Regatta (Tier 3). A registration link will be emailed to interested teams. No teams are allowed to register without prior approval!
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees by 1700 Friday, October 1, 2021. However, registration may closer earlier if spots are filled.

**4.5** The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: 30 teams between the 2 regattas. Priority will be given to Great Lakes Qualifier registrations. Additional interested teams will be placed on a waitlist.

## **5 FEES**

**5.1** Entry fees are as follows: \$50 per sailor. Teams consist of a minimum of 4 sailors and a maximum of 8 sailors.

**5.2** A light continental breakfast and a lunch will be included both Saturday and Sunday for registered sailors and 1 coach (listed in the registration). Additional lunches may be purchased for \$12/day.

## **6 SCHEDULE**

**6.1** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1000.

**6.2** On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1500.

## **7 COURSES**

**7.1** Courses will be set and sailed in accordance to the recommendations set forth in the ISSA Procedural Rules 2021-2024. Any changes will be noted in the Sailing Instructions.

## **8 SCORING**

**8.1** A minimum of three races in each division is required for a regatta to be scored.

**8.2** A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores, in accordance with ISSA PR.

**8.3** Great Lakes Qualifier and Dusty Waters Regatta will be scored separately in accordance with which regatta a team registered for.

## **9 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS**

**9.1** Each team must be accompanied by an adult advisor, parent or coach. Coaches must supply their own coach boats capable of on the water rotations.

**9.2** Support vessels shall keep clear of the race course and only coach from the SI designated area between races.

## **10 RISK STATEMENT**

**10.1** RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in**

**the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

**11 PRIZES**

**11.1** Trophies will be given for 1st-3rd overall for both Great Lakes Qualifier and Dusty Waters Regatta.

**11.2** The Great Lakes Qualifier is a qualifier for the Great Lakes Championship, the Shepherd Championship, and the Atlantic Coast Championship. The first place team will earn a berth to both the Great Lakes Championship and the Atlantic Coast Championship. The second through fourth place teams will earn a berth to the Great Lakes Championship, and the fifth through eighth place teams will earn berths to the Shepherd Championship. Berths not accepted in accordance with MISSA Rule 5.10 will be reallocated by the MISSA District Director.

**12 COVID-19**

**12.1** The sailing instructions may specify additional ISSA PR changes that affect the schedule, including (but not limited to): limiting equipment rotations, limiting sailor rotations between divisions, scheduling divisions during separate times, or sailing both divisions concurrently on the water.

**12.2** Health screenings may be required before entering regatta site
