2.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted no later than 0930 CDT on the day it will take effect.

4 BOATS

4.1 Club 420s will be provided by the White Bear Sailing School.

Boats will be sailed as provided. No modifications to the rigging are allowed.

Courses are shown below in SI Addendum B including the angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be passed.				
FORMAT				
The planned format is for rotations to occur throughout the day with A & B divisions sailing two races on and two races off. Rotations will occur on the WBSS floating dock.				

- 9 MARKS
- **9.1** Marks will be either orange or green buoys.
- 10 START/FINISH
- 10.1 The start and finish will be between an orange buoy and a WBSS gray zodiac.
- 11 COACHING
- Coaches are allowed to coach from water. Coach boats are not provided. Failure to provide your own coach boat, does not mean other coaches can not coach from the water.
- 12 SAFETY REGULATIONS
- All individuals on WBSS premises are required to wear face masks if inside for longer than a short bathroom break. All individuals must keep gear and stay outside unless to use bathrooms or for other necessary measures such as filing a protest.
- 13 RISK STATEMENT
- 13.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
