NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2021-2024, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the NWISA District Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The US Sailing prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2, and 63.4 will not be in effect.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. Mixed and active teams are allowed to compete. Teams not actively registered with NWISA will be scored as "Unregistered" in Techscore.
- 2.2. A responsible adult leader must accompany teams at all times.
- 2.3. Teams shall be comprised of a minimum of four sailors. Sailors may attend different high schools.
- 2.4. There are no numerical or age restrictions, or school restrictions on competitors. Sailors must be in grades 8-12.
- 2.5. Schools may enter multiple teams.

3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1. Eligible schools shall register through the NWISA website link. Registration opens 09-27-2021 at 1100.
- 3.2. Registration closes 10-04-2021 at 2200.
- 3.3. Teams unable to compete shall notify the Regatta Chair as soon as possible.
- 3.4. Each competing program must have a damage deposit on file with NWISA per District rule 7.3.
- 3.5. Entry fee
 - 3.5.1. \$10 per sailor, make checks payable to "Oak Harbor Youth Sailing."

4. BOATS

- 4.1. Races will be sailed in FJs.
- 4.2. Oak Harbor has six FJs. Teams are asked to bring additional FJs if possible.

5. SCHEDULE

Any changes to this schedule will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

6. RACING AREA

6.1. All races will be sailed West of the Oak Harbor Marina breakwater.

6.2. Rotations will take place from the Oak Harbor Marina breakwater.

7. COURSES

7.1. Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses. Short, collegiate style courses will be used.

8. SCORING

8.1. The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

9. FORMAT

9.1. The format will consist of two races in A division, followed by boat rotation, and two races in B division.

10. TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION

10.1. Teams are responsible for their own transportation. The address of the regatta site is: 1401 SE Catalina Dr. Oak Harbor, WA 98277.

11. COACHING

11.1. Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors, and other supporting personnel shall not go afloat in the racing area from Saturday morning to the end of racing Saturday unless an exemption has been explicitly permitted by the regatta chair. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors, and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

11.2. Competitors may receive coaching including instructions, assistance, equipment, or sustenance only while on designated rotation floats or ashore.

12. DRONES

12.1. The use of drones in the racing area is expressly prohibited, as stated in ISSA Procedural Rule 5.2.

13. OFFICIAL NOTICE FOR ALL COMPETITORS

13.1. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use), or marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which, by that contestant is unlawful under 21 US Code 841.

13.2. Infringements of this regulation and/or other inappropriate conduct occurring during the regatta, may be the basis for a hearing under RRS 69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing shall, at a time and place selected by it, meet to hear said protest, and it may impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions that it deems appropriate, including summary removal from the regatta.
