

# Tier 3 Regatta Chicago Yacht Club Saturday, Oct.9, 2021 Belmont Harbor, Chicago, IL



## NOTICE OF RACE

## 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Official Procedural Rules for Interscholastic Sailing Competition and the MISSA By-laws and District Rules will apply.
- 1.3 In accordance with Rule 70.5(a) and ISSA PR 20, decisions of the protest committee are final. US Sailing's permission has been granted.

## 2 ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 This event is a MISSA Tier 3 regatta open to MISSA member schools in good standing.
- 2.2 The regatta is limited to twenty (20) teams and entries are accepted on a time priority basis ("first-come, first-served"). Entries received in excess of the twenty-team limit will be recorded on a waiting list. If the number of teams entered falls below twenty-team limit prior to the entry deadline, entry will be offered to teams on the waiting list in time priority order.
- 2.3 Eligible schools may enter one team.

#### 3 ENTRY

- 3.1 A team may enter the regatta by completing the entry form and submitting the entry fee no later than the entry deadline. Each team is comprised of two sailors, a skipper and crew. The online entry form is available on the MISSA website and here: https://theclubspot.com/register/regatta/ko0fgomDP3/class
- 3.2 The entry deadline is 1700 on Friday, October 8th.
- 3.3 Completed team roster should be submitted online during the registration process.
- 3.4 A team that withdraws from the regatta after the entry deadline or fails to compete at the event shall forfeit its entry fee.
- 3.5 This is a single-division, non-rotational event.

#### 4 FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$20 per team, to be paid online. No food is being provided for this event.
- 4.2 Each team shall submit a refundable boat damage deposit of \$200 no later than 0845 on Saturday, October 9th. In the event of damage that cannot be attributed to a specific team, repair costs will be allocated evenly to all the teams competing.
- 4.3 Each team shall make damage deposit checks payable to Chicago Yacht Club

#### 5 BOATS

The Chicago Yacht Club will provide twenty (20) Zim e420s. Boats shall be sailed as provided. No other boats shall be used in the regatta.

#### 6 RACING AREA

The race area is in the open waters of Lake Michigan.

## 7 SCHEDULE

## Saturday, October 9th

0930 – Check-in, rigging of boats

1000- Mandatory competitors meeting (Races to follow). Races will continue throughout the day

1500 – No Warning after this time

## 8 COACHING

8.1 Coaching will take place on the water. Each coach shall operate a boat that will be his or her respective team's designated coaching area. Please plan on bringing your team's coaching platform. Many of CYC's RIBs are used for other concurrent events.

## 9 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top three teams.

## 10 HOUSING

There is no housing.
