SEAOTTER 2023 IMPORTANT NOTES

Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club – Restroom facilities are available at MPYC and throughout the beach and the harbor. Registration will take place in the Dry Storage yard located adjacent to the Del Monte Beach (on your left as you approach the wharf). The skippers meeting and awards ceremony will take place in the plaza at the entrance of the Clubhouse.

T-shirts and hats will be available for purchase inside the Clubhouse both days of the regatta. T-shirts and hats are \$20 each, cash or venmo.

Parking and Boat Trailers - All boat trailers should park in the paved public parking lot (Depot lot) on your left as you turn onto the Wharf. You can unload your boats and rig in that lot. Check-in at the registration tent to receive your inspection sheet. When your boat is ready for inspection, proceed towards the beach to find an inspector. After a successful inspection, you may pick up your sails and jib sheets.

Trailers left in the depot lot WITHOUT attached vehicles may be cited. To be safe, leave vehicles attached to trailer throughout the day.

Be sure to pay for parking at a kiosk or through the ParkMobile app!

Spectating and Team Camps – We will launch and rotate from the beach just north of the Pier. Often the best place to watch the racing is at the end of the pier. **Tents, awnings, chairs, banners, etc. are not allowed on the pier.** Spectators only! Please keep walkways and roads clear and navigable at all times for all guests to the pier. Team Camps, tents, banners, etc. can be set up on the beach.

The Monterey Beach House is running events on the beach in front of their property both days of the regatta. **Please do not set up tents, etc. on the beach in front of the Beach House**, which holds a permit to that area-- teams may set up to either side.
