1. Rules:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, the prescriptions of US Sailing, ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA District Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. In the event of a conflict between the governing documents, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence.
- 1.3. The organizing authority is MISSA in conjunction with Lake Forest Sailing
- 1.4. In accordance with Rule 70.5(a) and ISSA PR 20, the decision of the protest committee are final. US Sailing permission has been granted.

2. Qualification:

2.1. This event is a Qualifier for the Great Lakes Championship, the Shepherd Championship and the. The first through fourth place teams will earn a berth to Great Lakes Championship, and 5th-8th place teams will earn berths to the Shepherd Championship. Berths not accepted in accordance with MISSA Rule 5.10 will be reallocated by the MISSA District Director.

3. Eligibility:

- 3.1. Competing schools must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules prescribed in the Procedural Rules Part III.
- 3.2. Only MISSA Central District teams are eligible for this regatta.
- 3.3. All teams are required to have a designated on the water coach for safety and boat rotations.

4. Entry and Communications:

- 4.1. Teams can enter by paying the Entry Fee at ClubSpot https://theclubspot.com/regatta/BHHSDe3g0f by 1700 Central time on Friday September 22nd.
- 4.2. All entry fees are nonrefundable after 1700 Central time Friday September 22nd. Registrations are not transferable between teams.

5. Entry Fee:

5.1. The Entry Fee is \$200 per team, regardless of how many sailors are rostered.

6. Damage Deposit:

6.1. Each team shall submit a Damage Deposit Check of \$500 made out to "LF Rec." These checks shall be handed to the Regatta Chair in person by 0900h Saturday September 30th.

7. Boats:

- 7.1. LFS will provide C420s, boats shall be sailed as provided.
- 7.2. Coaches must bring their own coach boats capable of on the water rotations in Lake Michigan Conditions.
