On the Water Emergency

Serious/Life Threatening Injury Steps:

- 1. Ensure the area is safe
- 2. Make contact with programstaff (VHF 68)
- 3. Contact EMS
- 4. Administer first-aid as required until relieved by EMS
- **5. Complete Incident Report**

Be prepared to tell 911:

Current location of injured person
Description of boats (if applicable)
Evacuation Point (SEE BACKSIDE)
Age/gender/number of injured
Type of injury/situation
Your name and call back number

All official statements will come directly from EYC. Coaches, RC, sailors will not issue statements to reporters or post on social media

Serious/Life Threatening Injury:

Follow steps on top of page and meet EMS at NEAREST EXTRACTION point SEE BACKSIDE OF SHEET

Examples:

Severe Head Trauma
Unconscious/Unresponsive
Not Breathing
Heart Attack/Stroke
Severe Bleeding
Spinal/NeckInjury

Non-Life Threatening:

- 1. Ensure the area is safe
- 2. Render assistance
- 3. Coordinate dropoff atEYC
- 4. File incident report

Examples:

Heat Exhaustion
Hypothermia
Suspected Concussion
Broken Bone/Sprain
AllergicReaction (non-anaphylactic)
Asthma Attack
