NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the <u>ISSA Procedural Rules</u>, the <u>Scholastic Dinghy Class Rules</u>, the <u>SAISA District Supplemental Rules</u> and Code of Conduct, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. In the event of a conflict between the governing documents and the Sailing Instructions, the latter shall take precedence.
- 1.2. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Interscholastic Sailing Association in conjunction with Charleston Community Sailing.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

2.1. The Sailing Instructions will be posted on <u>TechScore</u> prior to the report time for the regatta.

3. COMMUNICATION:

3.1. The online official notice board will be TechScore.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 4.1. Competing schools must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.
- 4.2. Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach, or parent recognized by the school. The adult leader must have the authority to authorize medical care for all sailors on their team.
- 4.3. Eligible schools must enter by submitting an official entry form on <u>ClubSpot</u> by 5:00PM on December 1, 2025. When registering, please enter the name of the person completing registration under "skipper details." Crew and boat information can be left blank. An email will be sent verifying registration completion.
- 4.4. Teams unable to compete must notify the regatta chairperson as soon as possible and no later than the registration deadline.

5. FEES:

- 5.1. The entry is \$60 per team.
- 5.2. The entry fee can be paid at the end of registration on <u>ClubSpot</u> by credit card, debit card, or bank information.

5.3. There is no damage deposit for this event. Each school will be responsible for any damage that is incurred and will be billed for any necessary repairs.

6. BOATS:

- 6.1. Seventeen 420s will be provided by Charleston Community Sailing and Carolina Yacht Club. Boats will be sailed as provided.
- 6.2. After 17 teams have successfully registered, additional teams may be allowed to register, but will be required to bring a boat to add to the rotation. These details must be confirmed with the regatta chairperson before registration will be considered complete.

7. SCHEDULE:

- 7.1. Parking in the Carolina Yacht Club lot will be limited to one car per team. After the first car from a team is admitted, no additional cars from that team will be allowed to park on site. Please make arrangements to carpool. Additional cars may be parked either on the water side of East Battery Street for free or in the Safe Harbor Charleston City marina parking lot for a fee.
- 7.2. Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board.

8. RACING AREA:

- 8.1. All races will be sailed off the docks at the Carolina Yacht Club.
- 8.2. Boats 1-13 will be sailed back to the <u>Charleston Community Sailing dock</u> at the Safe Harbor Charleston City marina when racing concludes.

9. LUNCHES:

9.1. Lunches can be ordered by emailing Pam at beardenp3@gmail.com. Lunch will be a half turkey sub, chips, fruit, and a cookie and will cost \$12 each. Payment can be made via Venmo to Ryan-Hamm-3 or check, if approved by email with Pam. Lunch ordering will close at the end of the regatta registration period on Monday, December 1. Please note that the Boathouse restaurant at Carolina Yacht Club will not be open for non-members.

10. COACHING:

10.1. Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors, and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from 6:00AM on Saturday until after racing has ended unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chairperson. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors, and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

11. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS:

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

12. WAIVER OF LIABILITY:

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any

competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
