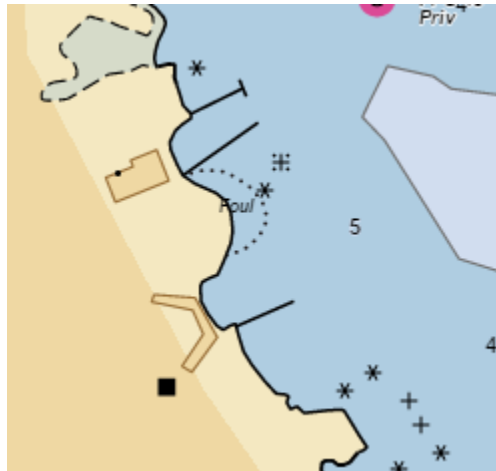
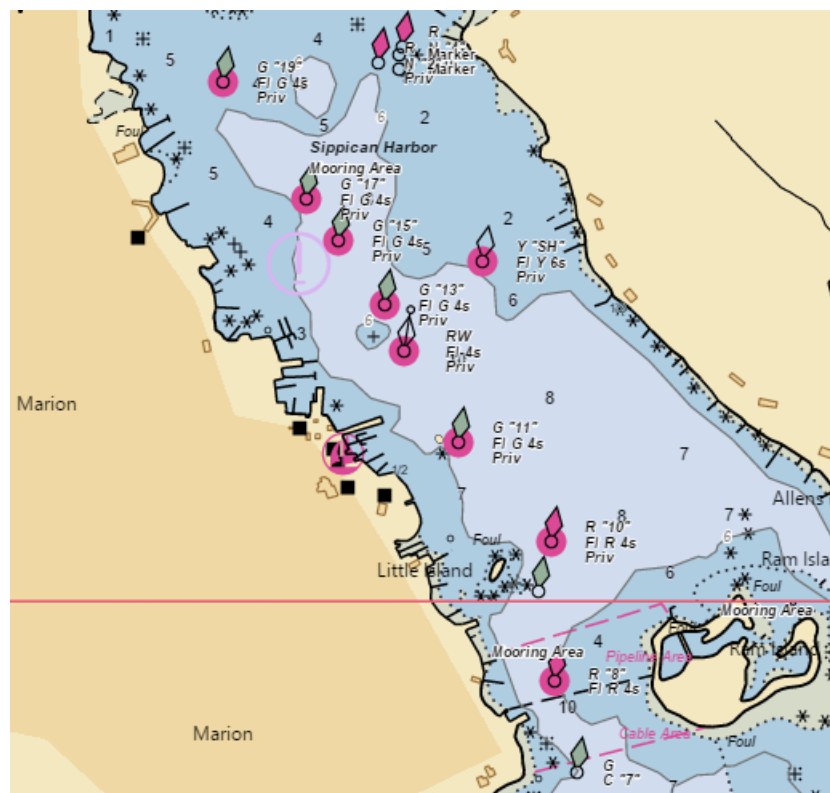


Appendix B – Harbor Map and Hazards

Rocks lie north and south of Tabor's sailing dock.



Please sail straight out to the mooring field, then turn toward the race area. Stay within the mooring field as you sail to the race area. An area without moorings is shallow, rocky, or in the middle of the channel.



After passing the Beverly YC, please do not pass between the small rock island and the channel marker G9.

The channel does an S-turn to the west near Ram Island at the mouth of the harbor.

Small boats don't need to follow the channel, but the waters west of Ram Island get shallow quickly, and the waters south of Ram Island are very rocky. Give the island some space.

A white “No Wake” buoy marks a safe point to steer toward.



The racecourse will be set near government mark R6, southwest of Ram Island.
