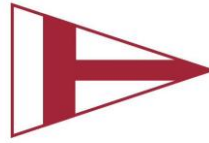


G. Wiley Wakeman Fleet Race – Now in 3D!

NOTICE OF RACE**



1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules, and the Scholastic Dinghy Class Rules.

1.2. ISSA PR 2.2 is in effect anytime a sailor or coach is on the water, whether aboard a boat or on a dock, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted on [TechScore](#) prior to the report time for the regatta.

3. COMMUNICATION

The online official notice board will be [TechScore](#).

4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1. This event is open to all school sailing teams. NESSA or ISSA membership is not required to enter.

4.2. Team Composition. This is a three-division event. A team consists of one skipper and one crew for each division. Schools may bring additional substitute sailors without limit. ISSA PR 4.2 governs sailor movement between divisions once the regatta begins: a sailor who has skippered in a division may not sail in another division for the rest of the event, and a sailor who has only crewed may move to another division but is then locked into it for the rest of the event.

4.3. NESSA PR Article L (Penalty for Failure to Compete) is not in effect for this regatta. A team that needs to withdraw is asked to notify the event organizer as soon as possible so the open space can be offered to another team.

4.4. Entry is limited to nine teams. Teams still wishing to compete after the event is filled will be added to a waitlist on a first come, first served basis.

4.5. A school that wishes to enter more than one team should contact the event coordinator directly.

5. FLEETS AND BOATS

5.1. A Division (collegiate FJs), B Division (E420s), and C Division (E420s) will be given separate starts, with no scheduled break in racing.

5.2. There will be no rotation of boats in this event; each team will race the same boat throughout the regatta.

6. ENTRY PROCEDURE

6.1. Schools wishing to compete must register online via the [event registration form link](#).

6.2. There is no entry fee.

6.3. A list of registered teams is maintained and available at the [registration tracker link](#).

7. SCHEDULE

Saturday, September 19, 2026

- 11:00 AM – Report time / check-in at the Tabor Sailing Center, 235 Front Street, Marion, MA.
- 11:30 AM – Sailors' meeting. Racing will begin as soon as practicable after the sailors' meeting.
- 3:00 PM – No race may start after this time.

8. RACING AREA

All races will be sailed in the vicinity of nun R6 in Outer Sippican Harbor, Marion, MA.

9. COURSES

The Race Committee will determine courses as prescribed in ISSA PR 7.8.

10. SCORING

The regatta will be scored in accordance with the ISSA Procedural Rules.

11. COACHING

Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors, and other support personnel may be afloat in the sailing area during the regatta.

12. RIGHTS TO USE NAME, IMAGE, AND LIKENESS

ISSA PR 5.3 shall apply.

13. WAIVER OF LIABILITY

13.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race.

13.2. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
