

Minnesota School Sailing Spring Conference Regatta #5 May 9, 2015 White Bear Sailing School Dellwood, MN



NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the 2013-2016 ISAF RRS, and will be run in accordance with the 2013-2016 Interscholastic Sailing Association Procedural Rules (unless modified by this NOR), this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILTY:

A "Team" shall be made up of a minimum of 4 sailors, between the grades of 7-12. Mixed teams (comprised of students from different schools) are allowed. However, we would like to encourage schools to make "True" teams first (comprised of students from the same school), before making mixed teams with remaining sailors.

3. BOATS:

3.1 Club 420s. Boats shall be sailed as provided by WBSS.

3.2 Boats will be checked in and out upon launch and pull-out. Any previously existing damage should be reported upon launching. Any new damage should be reported between races or upon pull out.

4. REGATTA FORMAT:

This will be a two-division regatta without rotations. Each team will randomly draw their boat assignment at registration. Each team will rotate their A and B division into that boat.

5. ENTRY:

5.1 Each team must notify Nick Hovland (<u>sailwbss@gmail.com</u>, 701.388.6612) of the number of sailors they expect to bring **no later than Thursday, May 7 by 6:30PM.**

5.2 The entry fee is \$20 per sailor. The fee includes lunch on Saturday. **Checks should be made payable to "WBSS."**

5.3 Each high school will be allowed one free lunch for their coach.

5.4 Additional meal plans for non-competitors may be purchased for \$5. These requests should accompany that team's entry form.

6. SAFETY:

1.1 Every sailor, coach, regatta official, spectator, or anyone else affiliated with the regatta is required to wear a US Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Devices (PFD) at all times—shore to shore—while on the water.

1.2 Dry Suits are not required but are strongly encouraged. In the event of capsize or equivalent water immersion, the boat of any sailor not wearing a dry suit will be immediately sent to shore for the remainder of a given rotation.

7. SCHEDULE:

Saturday, May 9, 2015 0800- Check in and Registration 0800-0900- Rigging of boats 0900- Competitors meeting mandatory for all sailors 0945- First Warning. Races will continue throughout the day. Lunch will be served on shore between sets 1500- No race shall start after this time.
