1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and 2013 - 2016, USS prescriptions, including Appendix D, Team Racing Rules will apply except as modified by ISSA procedural rule 12. This Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. In the event of a conflict between the governing documents and the Sailing Instructions, SIs shall take precedence.
- 1.3. The Official Procedural Rules and Supplemental rules for Interscholastic Sailing Competition (MISSA and ISSA) will apply.
- 1.4. The following US Sailing Prescriptions will not apply: 60, 63.2, and 63.4.
- 1.5. The regatta is a team racing event.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1. This is a MISSA Tier 2 event
- 2.2. This event is open to MISSA West area schools only.
- 2.3. Teams must be members of MISSA and ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules.
- 2.4. A team shall have no fewer than six sailors
- 2.5. Eligible schools may only enter one team

3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS:

- 3.1. Teams may enter by contacting Matthew Thompson (Matthew@wayzatasailing.org) with their intention to compete by 1700 on April 14th including a roster of sailors and coach's contact information.
- 3.2. Teams will complete an entry form, turn in fees and boat damage deposit to the registration table by 0845 on April 23rd
- 3.3. A team that withdraws from the regatta after the entry deadline or fails to compete at the event will forfeit its entry fee.
- 3.4. Qualifying teams from this event must accept their berth MISSA Baker Quals in accordance with District Rule 11.

4. FEES:

- 4.1. The entry fee is \$40 per competitor
- 4.2. Lunch is included on both Saturday and Sunday.
- 4.3. Each registered school will receive one additional lunch for their designated coach.
- 4.4. All checks should be made payable to WCSC
- 4.5. A damage deposit of \$40 per sailor must be submitted with registration. This is refundable if the boat and gear are returned undamaged. It is the responsibility of

each competitor to report damage as soon as possible to the organizer. In the event damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided evenly amongst all the competing teams.

5. BOATS:

5.1. Collegiate style Z 420s will be provided by local host sailing schools

Trophy presentation at WCSC will take place ASAP after racing concludes and boats are derigged and checked by a WCSC representative.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

7.1. Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration on Saturday April 23, 2016.

8. EVENT SITE:

8.1. WCSC, 1000 Eastman Lane, Wayzata, MN 55391

8.2. Please do not drop-off or park on Arlington Circle unless directed to

9. RACING AREA:

9.1. The racing area will be inside Wayzata Bay on Lake Minnetonka within easy rotation distance

10. SCORING

10.1. The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

10.2. We will attempt to complete two full round robins to determine the top 5 teams who will advance to the MISSA Baker Qualifier.

11. PROTESTS:

11.1. Protests must be submitted on time within the filing period, and competitors must follow proper protocol to file a protest and have it be considered valid. On the

water umpires may be present to enforce the rules as prescribed by ISSA PR Appendix 7 and RRS Appendix D.

- 11.2. Coaches may be expected to act as umpires or protest committee for their team's races.

12. COACHING:

- 12.1. Communication between coaches and sailors during the hours of competition (defined as the time between the start of the sequence for the first race, and the completion of the last race) will be limited to the shore at WCSC unless otherwise adjusted.

13. HOUSING:

- 13.1. Housing may be provided on a first come, first serve basis. Please contact Matthew Thompson (matthew@wayzatasailing.org) once registered with the following information; the number of sailors needing housing, additional chaperones, and a contact phone number and email address.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

- 14.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
