

2018 Phebe Corckran King Memorial Regatta

Important venue information

- 1. There is no parking available at Severn Sailing Association (SSA) or Annapolis Yacht Club (AYC) for this event. Street parking in Eastport is free, just make sure the curb is not painted red where you park.
- 2. SSA has three other sailboat classes racing this weekend and we ask that all sailors, parents, and coaches are respectful of the club at its grounds.
- 3. As guests, we are welcomed to use the upper porch and upper level of the clubhouse. All regatta activities will take place at SSA, the FJs live at SSA and the 420s live at AYC. Please keep the Snack Bar area(below the upper deck) free of gear and sailors.
- 4. Locker rooms are located on the lower level, inside. Participants are welcome to use these to change in, but please do not leave gear/bags in there. They serve the entire club, see #2.
- 5. A filtered water bottle fill/drinking fountain is located outside the locker rooms. We encourage all participants to use this verse bringing disposable bottles.
- 6. Please put all trash and recyclables into the appropriate cans which are located throughout the club grounds.
- 7. SSA is an active club. The members ask that you do not impede the use of their boats, or place personal items or sit on boats or trailers. Along with the other fleets racing this weekend, many members will be down working on their boats.
- 8. There is a "snack bar" located under the deck on the lower level. It is operated by an outside company. They will be open from 8am to 10am and then from 2pm-5pm for normal club operation. They do have another

location just a few hundred yards from SSA. You can order lunches and pick them up from the 2nd Street location on both days. Their website is <u>www.breadandbutterkitchen.com</u>.

- 9. Check in will be located on the second floor of the SSA club house. Damage deposits will be collected and tech shirts will be available.
- 10.A simple continental breakfast is being provided both days.
- 11. After sailing on Saturday, we will have a social function for the sailors with food and raffle giveaways. This will start as soon as all the boats are stored at the respective clubs. Sailors must be present to win.
- 12.We use the SSA fleet of FJ's and the AYC fleet of 420's. The divisions will switch for the second day of sailing. All sailors should report to SSA Saturday and Sunday morning.
- 13. The official notice board and station will be located by the hoists at the "outer basin". This will serve as regatta central.
- 14. Rotations will take place inside the outer basin. No rotations of boats should occur outside of the basin on the outer side of the docks.
- 15. The division not currently sailing will be kept on the dock until notified that they can leave.
- 16.Please notify Mark Bennett if you would like to schedule Friday practice time. We will do our best to get teams and coaches on the water.
- 17.Please provide Mark Bennett with your intended roster. Names will be used to enter into the raffle. Corrections to your roster should be made Saturday morning.
