TEAM-RACE REGATTA
18 May 2019

1. RULES: Notice of Race

- 1.1 - This regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, The ISSA Procedural Rules, this NOR, and the SIs, with the SIs taking precedence in the event of a conflict.
- 1.2 - The Organizing Authority (OA) is The Hotchkiss School Sailing Team.
- 1.3 - The venue is Lake Wononscopomuc, 50 Lake Road, Lakeville, CT 06039.
- 1.4 - Protests will be heard by the coaches at the event and will be 3-minute justice at the end of the race where the alleged infraction occurred. It is the intention of the OA to have the two coaches from the competing teams hear the protests, remembering that this is a JV, non-ladder event and the emphasis is learning.

2. ELIGIBILITY & TEAM COMPOSITION:

- 2.1 - This regatta is open to NESSA members or invitees of The Hotchkiss School.
- 2.2 - Teams should register, before May 14, 2019 by sending an email to: Roger Rawlings, rrowling@hotchkiss.org
- 2.3 - Teams shall be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.
- 2.4 - This regatta is intended for Junior Varsity level teams and players.
- 2.5 - If necessary, The Hotchkiss School will fill vacant round-robin spots with additional teams. If a school would like to bring more than one team, please ask Roger if that is possible.

3. BOATS:

- 3.1 - ZIM FJ's circa 2019 and Vanguard 420s circa 2008 provided by the OA.
- 3.2 - Boats will be sailed as provided.

4. SCHEDULE:

- 4.1 - Saturday, May 18, 2019 — **CLINIC DAY**
 - 0900 - Check in/registration/rigging of boats
 - 0930 - Sailors' meeting
 - First start as soon as possible after meeting.
 - Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board whose location will be announced at the sailors meeting. Lunch will be the responsibility of each team during an 'off' rotation.

5. COURSES:

- 5.1 - The Race Committee will determine the courses based on conditions, with a strong preference for a digital N.

6. FORMAT

- 6.1 - A double round robin format is planned with each school sailing each other at least twice. If conditions allow, a third round will be sailed. Ties will be broken per ISSA Procedural Rules.

7. SCORING:

- 7.1 - The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

8. PRIZES:

- 8.1 - No prizes will be awarded

9. WAIVER OF LIABILITY:

- 9.1 - Sailing is an activity with inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
