### **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### **1. RULES:**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), The ISSA Procedural Rules and MISSA Supplemental Rules shall apply. In accordance with Rule 70.5(a) and ISSA PR 20, decisions of the protest committee are final.
- 1.2 RRS Appendix P will apply as modified per ISSA PR. 14(c).
- 1.3 The following US Sailing Prescriptions do not apply: RRS 63.1 and RRS 63.2

#### **2. ELIGIBILITY:**

- 2.1 This is a MISSA Tier 1 event. Competing schools must be members in good standing of MISSA and schools and sailors must meet MISSA eligibility requirements.
- 2.2 All sailors must be listed on their team's official roster registered online with ISSA.
- 2.3 Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.
- 2.4 Selection of competing schools will be by qualification. The Mallory qualifier has 20 berths. West (5), East (7), Central (8). The top 4 teams will earn a berth to the Mallory Championships, June 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> in Cleveland, OH. In addition, teams may qualify for the Phebe Corkran King Regatta in Annapolis, MD. Berths must be accepted in accordance with MISSA District Rule 5.10.
- 2.5 No registration will be considered complete until all fees, required registration, forms and signatures are received.
- 2.6 Registration will be open for competitors on April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 0900 Eastern Standard Time.

#### **3. REGISTRATION AND ENTRY:**

- 3.1 Teams must enter the regatta by completing the registration form online and submitting the entry fee no later than the entry deadline. The entry fee is \$60 per sailor. The fee includes lunch for each registered team and their coach both days.
- 3.2 Additional lunches for non-competitors may be purchased.
- 3.3 A damage deposit of \$200.00 must be submitted by each team no later than 0800 on May 15<sup>th</sup>. This is refundable if the boat(s) sailed are returned undamaged. In the event damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided evenly amongst all the competing teams.
- 3.4 Damage deposit checks should be made payable to Foundry Sailing Association.
- 3.5 Registration deadline is 1700 EST on May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021
- 3.6 Registration will be through MISSA at <https://hssailing.org/machform/view.php?id=44150>

- 3.8 Teams that withdraw from the regatta after 1700 on May 5<sup>th</sup> will forfeit their registration fee.
- 3.9 Teams unable to compete must notify the regatta chairperson, MISSA District Director and League Representative.

#### **4. BOATS:**

- 4.1 The Foundry will provide (20) 420Es. Boats will be sailed as provided.
- 4.2 The 420E class association rules do not apply.

**5. FORMAT:**

5.1 The regatta will consist of A and B divisions in a round robin format. Each team will draw their boat at check-in and that will be the boat their A and B division sails for the regatta. There will be NO boat rotations. One race constitutes a regatta.

**6. RACING AREA/VENUE**

6.1 The race area will be located inside the West Basin of Cleveland Harbor.

**7. SCORING:**

7.1 The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

**8. SCHEDULE:**

**Saturday, May 15th**

0800 – Check In

0830 – Rigging of boats

0900 – Mandatory competitors' meeting

0930 – Launch

10:00 – First warning – races will continue throughout the day

**Sunday, May 16th**

0800 – Rigging of boats

0845 – Competitors meeting (if necessary)

0930 – Warning signal for first race

1500 – No warning signal shall take place after this time

Awards to follow

8.1 Changes to the schedule will be posted on the notice board.

**9. COACH/SPECTATOR/SUPPORT BOATS:**

9.1 Coaches must remain onshore unless otherwise directed by the PRO, regatta chair, or the Foundry Director of Sailing. A & B division rotations will take place at the docks at the Station's basin. In order to limit the number of people at the Station, there will be designated areas at Wendy Park for spectators in order to limit the number of people at the Station due to Covid-19 guidelines.

**10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:**

Sailing instructions will be available at check-in and on the TechScore website. Changes to the schedule or Amendments will be posted on the official notice board located inside the boathouse.

**11. SAFETY:**

All competitors, parents, coaches will be required to follow state and federal guidelines regarding health & safety. Face coverings/masks are required on-shore, in the boathouse, main building and on the docks while rigging.

11.1 Competitors, judges, race committee members, host staff and one coach from each team will be permitted at the Station.

11.2 Spectators must remain at Wendy Park during the regatta.

**12. HOUSING:**

Local hotels recommended: Crown Plaza at Playhouse Square, Aloft, Hampton Inn, Doubletree Downtown Cleveland, Hilton Downtown, Ritz Carlton or any Airbnb in the Cleveland, Lakewood, Rocky River area.

**13. TRAVEL, TRANSPORTATION & PARKING:**

Competitors flying into the area should use Cleveland Hopkins International Airport. The best GPS address to the sailing center is 2800 Whiskey Island Drive. That will take you to the Whiskey Island Still & Eatery. Due to construction of the new pedestrian bridge, we will be sending out additional parking details closer to the event. Please be prepared to walk about 10-15 minutes from the parking area to the Station.
