SAILING INSTRUCTIONS ADDENDUM 1

1. RULES:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), including the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules (PR), the MASSA District Supplemental Rules (includes SI's), the Notice of Race (NOR), and this Addendum to the Sailing Instructions (SI's). In the event of a conflict, the Sailing Instructions Addendum will take precedence.
- 1.2 In accordance with RRS 70.5(a) decisions of the protest committee are final. US Sailing permission has been granted.
- 1.3 The organizing Authority is the Mid-Atlantic Interscholastic Sailing Association (MASSA) in conjunction with the Maryland Interscholastic Sailing Association (MDISA) and Sailing Center Chesapeake.

2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:

2.1 Official notices including changes to sailing instructions will be posted on the official notice board located on the equipment shed and in Techscore. Changes to the sailing instructions shall be approved by the regatta chair and posted no later than one half hour prior to the first warning signal on the day it will take effect.

3. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

Saturday, May 15

0800-0830 - Report time/Rigging of boats

0800-0815: New York/New Jersey teams arrive

0815-0830: Maryland/Virginia teams arrive

0930 - First Warning

There will be no cut off time for racing.

Sunday, May 16

0930 - First Warning

1500 - No race will start after this time, with the exception of any sail off, if needed

3.1 Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board located on the equipment shed and in Techscore.

4. TEAM AREAS:

4.1 Teams are asked to establish team areas separate from one another.

5. FORMAT:

- 5.1 The regatta is two divisions, rotating divisions (but not boats) every two races. Teams will have the same boat all day.
- 5.2 Teams will be assigned a boat number for the weekend.
- 5.3 Rotations will be on the SCC beach where boats were rigged each morning.
- 5.4 The Race Committee will attempt to complete one round robin (15 races per division).

6. PROTESTS:

- 6.1 In accordance with PR 16(d), the time limit for filing a protest or request for redress shall be 30 minutes after the Race Committee Boat lands. The protest is filed by completing a protest form and notifying the protest chair. Notification may be by radio.
- 6.2 Protest Forms, etc. will be available at the shore support table at the waterfront.

7. BREAKDOWNS:

- 7.1 Competitors are responsible for inspecting their assigned boats before each race for possible breakdowns and missing equipment. Discrepancies must be resolved immediately.
- 7.2 Competitors shall report any damage, breakdown, or loss of equipment, however slight, to the regatta representative managing rotations on the changing dock immediately upon arriving on shore and to the race committee finish boat on the water immediately after all boats in their race have finished. Compliance with this instruction is required regardless of whether a scoring change for a breakdown is being requested. Failure to make this report will be subject to such penalty as the protest committee may impose, including loss of one or more race wins. This changes RRS 64.1(a).

8 SAFETY:

- 8.1 Competitors shall wear inherently buoyant personal flotation devices designated as USCG "wearable" in accordance with ISSA PR 2.2. Inflatable type PFDs are not permitted.
- 8.2 The race committee may require the use of drysuits or full-length wetsuits if the combined air and water temperature is below 120 degrees. This may be announced daily, and need not be signaled.

9 COURSES AND MARKS:

- 9.1 Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses as prescribed in ISSA PR
- 7.8. The race committee may designate the course selection orally at the start line.
- 9.3 Course marks will be yellow spheres. Red spheres may be used for a starting pin and windward offset.

10. PRIZES:

10.1 Prizes will be not be awarded.
