NOTICE OF RACE- Rev. 2/12/2021

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the SAISA COVID document, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. In the event of a conflict between the governing documents and the Sailing Instructions the latter shall take precedence.
- 1.2. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Interscholastic Sailing Association in conjunction with the host Club.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1. Competing schools must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules, Part III 1, and 5.2. Only Varsity teams are eligible per the SAISA January Update.
- 2.2. Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school. Teams are limited to 6 sailors and 2 support persons only. **The adult leader must have the authority to authorize medical care for all sailors on their team and will be responsible for all team members following COVID protocols.**
- 2.3. Teams registering accept the SAISA COVID protocols including the requirement to wear masks at all times on the grounds and docks, the limited number of participants, no spectators, and other restrictions that may be added.

3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS :

- 3.1. Eligible teams must enter by submitting an official entry on-line at www.charlestoncommunitysailing.org, the "News & Events" tab and then "Regatta Entry" tab and paying the entry fee through the PayPal tab. No checks will be accepted. In the "Comments" section provide the name and contact phone # of the two adult representatives that will accompany the team.
- 3.2. All teams must be paid active members of ISSA, have sailor names with ISSA correspond to sailor names entered in the regatta, and have a current active Techscore account. Registration will close at 5PM on Mon. Feb. 22. An email will be sent within 24 hours verifying your completed registration.
- 3.3. Teams unable to compete must notify the regatta chairperson by the registration deadline. See SAISA Supplemental Rule 4.7
- 3.4. All scoring, sailing instructions, and regatta notices will be posted on Techscore under the SAISA North Points 2 regatta.

4. ENTRY FEE:

- 4.1. The entry is \$45 per team and must be paid on-line when registering.

5. DAMAGE DEPOSIT:

No damage deposit will be collected in advance of the event. Teams entering agree that any damage occurring while the boat is in the teams' possession will be paid by the team representative after accessing the repairs.

6. BOATS:

- 6.1. Eighteen 420 sailboats with Zim and Laser Performance sails will be provided by Charleston Community Sailing and Carolina Yacht Club. Boats will be sailed as provided.
- 6.2. When 18 teams have successfully registered, additional teams may be allowed to bring their own boat.
- 6.3. Boats will not be rotated. Boats will be assigned at random and teams will be notified of their boat assignment and location. 'A' division sailors should be dropped at that venue at the designated time for rigging and sail to the racing area. The remainder of the team will drive to JIYC.

7. SCHEDULE:

Thursday, February 25:

ZOOM Skippers meeting with coach or designated parent.

Saturday, Feb. 27

9:30AM Rig at designated location (Boat# 1-13 are located at CCS dock, Safe Harbor Charleston City Marina, 17 Lockwood Dr., Boat# 14-18 are located at Carolina Yacht Club, 50 East Bay St.)

10AM Dock departure

- 7.1 Changes to the schedule will be communicated on the Techscore Notice Board or by group email.

8. RACING AREA:

- 8.1 All races will be sailed off of docks at the James Island Yacht Club, 734 Wampler Dr, Charleston, 29412

9. COURSES:

- 9.1. Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses as prescribed in ISSA PR 7.7.

10. SCORING:

- 10.1. The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

11. Gear Requirement:

Appropriate sailing gear for the water temperature and air temperature will be required for all sailors. No cotton clothing such as jeans or sweatshirts will be allowed and proper foot wear is required. Wet suits or dry suits are highly recommended. Coaches are asked to monitor gear of their team members. The organizing authority reserves the right to remove any sailor that they feel is not properly outfitted for conditions.

12. COACHING:

- 12.1. Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chairperson. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.
- 12.2. Coach or team leader must file the Record of Participation information directly on to Techscore by the end of the protest time limit. Failure to do so will result in penalties prescribed in ISSA Rules.

OFFICIAL NOTICE:

- 12.3. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, marijuana or any other controlled substance, as defined in 21 U.S. Code 802, the possession of which is unlawful under U.S. Code 841, or alcoholic beverages (distilled spirits, wine, and beer, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use). An alleged breach of this procedural rule shall not be grounds for a protest. However, when a report is received from any source, alleging such a breach a protest committee consisting of the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA Board of

Directors, and the chairperson of the protest committee, shall follow the process described in RRS 69.1(b). If a hearing under RRS 69 is held, a competitor found to have breached this procedural rule shall be excluded from the remaining races of the series and, where practical, be removed from the regatta venues and sent home. Additional penalties consistent with RRS 69.2 may be imposed on the competitor or the competitor's team. This regulation is in effect during the entire event from the date and time of arrival through the date and time of departure from the regatta site.

13. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS:

- 13.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

14. WAIVER OF LIABILITY:

- 14.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 14.2. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
