Location: Culver Academies Naval Building, Lake Maxinkuckee, Indiana.

Class: 420: 20 boats available for visitors, 12 teams maximum.

1. Rules:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, the prescriptions of US Sailing, ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA District rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. In the event of a conflict between the governing documents, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence.
- 1.2 The organizing authority is MISSA in conjunction with Culver Academies.

2. Eligibility:

- 2.1 Competing schools must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in Procedural Rules Part III. This regatta is open to 7th & 8th grade students per MISSA rule 4.3. Mixed teams are allowed per MISSA rule 4.4.
- 2.2 While on the Culver campus, teams must be accompanied by a designated adult, who may be a coach or chaperon recognized by the school.

3. Entry and Communications:

- 3.1 Teams can enter by submitting the Entry Form by 1700 Eastern Time on Thursday, 6 May, 2021.
- 3.2 Each school may initially enter one team (1 A Division and 1 B Division) with or without alternates. Mix teams are allowed and must be so entered in Techscore.
- 3.3 Each team must complete and Entry Form and waiver. The Entry Form must be completed and submitted before the end of registration on Saturday May 8. Incomplete or missing forms will result in the respective team/school being excluded from the regatta. Forms are to be emailed to joe.hanko@culver.org.
- 3.4 Entered teams unable to compete must notify the Regatta Chairperson and their MISSA representative as soon as possible.



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3.5 If there are unfilled berths in the regatta by the entry deadline, entry of additional teams will be allowed. Please contact Regatta Chairperson for more information.

4. Entry Fee

4.1 There is NO entry fee for this regatta.

5. Damage Deposits

5.1 A damage deposit of (\$250.00) **per 420 boat** is required. The refundable boat damage deposit may be submitted via mail before the regatta, or in cash or check at regatta registration. Schools that fail to do so will not compete. The deposit is refundable provided all equipment and boats are returned undamaged. All boats will be inspected prior to and after sailing for preexisting and new damage. Any school that modifies, changes, or otherwise improperly rigs their boat's rigging, halyards, or other equipment and components, will be **charged** the necessary amount from their damage deposit to return the boat to its pre-race condition.

6. Housing

6.1 Housing is not available at Culver for this one day regatta.

7. Boats

- 7.1 20 C 420s will be provided by Culver Academies. Boats will be sailed as provided. Competitors may bring telltales for shrouds.
- 7.2 Dock space is available for visiting team coach boats. A limited number of Whaler 17's will be available for visiting coaches.

8. Regatta Format

- 8.1 This is a one day, two-division (A and B) regatta. <u>There will be no rotations</u>. Each school will be randomly assigned two boats, one for A and B divisions respectively. Each team's divisions will compete the entire regatta in their assigned boats. This will allow for distancing of competitors, while affording a complete regatta experience.
- 8.2 Both A and B division boats will sail each race from the same start as one fleet. Races will be run continuously until the expiration of the time limit, or termination of racing by the Race Committee. There may be a break for lunch ashore.



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- 8.3 Each team will be assigned an area to park in the field directly across from their boats on the beach. These lanes will afford teams physical distancing from each other. Pop up tents and similar shelters are encouraged.
- 8.4 Food and beverages will not be provided by the organizers. Each team is responsible for their own meals.
- 8.5 Face coverings are required when within 6 ft. of each other outdoors, per Indiana IHSAA rules.
- 8.6 Coaches, chaperons, and spectators welcome, all must wear face coverings while on the property.
- 8.7 All Culver buildings are closed to all visitors.

10. Awards

10.1 Winners will be announced, but there will be no awards ceremony. 1st place team will have their name added to the Scrappy perpetual trophy.

11. Official Notice

- 11.1 Losses and damages to borrowed equipment due to willful, wanton, negligent or careless handling of equipment shall be the responsibility of the school or team members. By submitting registration the respective school agrees and guarantees reimbursement to the Culver Educational Foundation in the event of such loss or damage.
- 11.2 The Culver Academies campus is tobacco free and any such use will result in immediate dismissal from the property of the offender by Campus Security.

12. Rights to Use Name and Likeness

12.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.



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13. Waiver of Liability

- 13.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 13.2 The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host organization, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
