NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The Official ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA Procedural Rules and District Rules will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Eligible competitor shall be enrolled full-time in grades 7 through 12. This is a Tier 3 regatta.
- 2.2. An "A" division & "B" division team shall consist of a skipper and crew. Teams must be minimum of 4 sailors with a maximum of 8 sailors per team. A school may enter 2 teams. More spots may be assigned as can be accommodated. This will be a 2-Division rotating regatta. Maximum of 13 A/B teams.
- 2.3. An eligible team may enter by completing the online entry form and submitting it by May 13th. Please complete one entry form per team. The online entry form is available at: <u>https://www.eventbrite.com/e/tulip-regatta-tickets-151229169517</u>
- 3. BOATS
 - 3.1. Club 420's will be provided by Macatawa Bay Junior Association. Standing Rigging may not be adjusted for the duration of the event.
- 4. BOAT DAMAGE:
 - 4.1. A damage deposit of \$200 must be submitted at registration on May 15th. This is refundable if the boat and gear are returned undamaged. Teams not having this deposit will not be able to compete. In the event damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair cost will be divided evenly among all the competing teams.
 - 4.2. Make checks payable to MBJA.





5. FEES

5.1. The fee is \$30 per team for the regatta.

6. RACING AREA:6.1. All races will be sailed on the water of Lake Macatawa adjacent to Macatawa Bay Yacht Club.

COURSES: 7.1. In accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules

8. SCORING:

8.1. The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

9. COACHING:

9.1. Team leaders, coaches, other support personnel will be allowed to go afloat in the sailing area during the time of the regatta.

10. COVID -19

- 10.1. Due to the evolving situation with COVID-19, no food will be provided by the event organizers and teams will be encouraged to bring their own food for the event.
- 10.2. Masks or Face Coverings must be worn at all times inside the Junior Sailing Center and during competitors' meetings and award ceremonies.

11. PRIZES:

11.1. Prizes will be awarded to the schools placing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in the regatta. Medals will be given to the top 3 boats in Division A and B.
