## **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### 1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the <u>ISSA Procedural Rules</u> and the <u>ISSA National Championship General Conditions</u> and <u>the Scholastic Dinghy Class Rules</u>.
- 1.2. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Interscholastic Sailing Association in conjunction with host Mission Bay Yacht Club & the Pacific Coast Interscholastic Sailing Association LLC.
- 1.3. Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, as modified by ISSA Procedural Rule 14(c) will be in effect.
- **2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The sailing instructions will be posted on Tech Score prior to the report time for the regatta.
- **3. COMMUNICATION:** The online official notice board will be Tech Score.

#### 4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. Competing schools and competitors must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.
- 4.2. Selection of competing schools will be by district elimination. The regatta has 20 berths. Allocations will be determined by the ISSA Board. Schools should contact their district directors to find out details on district qualifiers.
- 4.3. Eligible schools and sailors must enter by submitting the official entry form, regatta fees, and damage deposit online by **1700 May 20<sup>th</sup>**, **2022.** If the elimination for your district is to be held after this date, please have the district director contact the regatta chair immediately so arrangements can be made.
- 4.4. All forms and payments should be done online at: https://hssailing.org/machform/view.php?id=167495
- 4.5. Teams unable to compete must notify the regatta chair and ISSA as soon as possible.
- 4.6. ISSA will reallocate vacant district quotas. The first open allocation will go to the host district. A berth becomes vacant when the qualifying district becomes unable to fill the berth.

#### 5. FEES:

- 5.1. The entry is \$500 per school. This includes boat and sail charters (two per team), light continental breakfast for up to 9 people (1 Coach & 8 Competitors), Saturday BBQ, T-shirts, trophy snack and awards for top placing teams.
- 5.2. The Credit Card used for this Entry Fee Payment will also be used to secure a Damage Deposit of \$250 per incident. No charges will be made to the Credit Card for Damage Deposit purposes until matters have been discussed by the host with the team adult representative. In the event damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided evenly amongst all the competing teams.
- **6. BOATS:** Class Legal CFJ's will be provided by host. Boats will be sailed as provided.

**8. RACING AREA:** All races will be sailed on Mission Bay to the east of the club. A Division will sail/rotate off Main Clubhouse dock and B Division will sail/rotate off Junior Building dock.

#### 9. TRAVEL AND HOUSING:

- **9.1.** Competitors should use the San Diego Airport.
- 9.2. Please use commonly available online search and booking tools for hotel and other travel accommodations. San Diego is a major travel hub and event center with a wide variety of options for all travel needs.

## 10. COACHING:

- **10.1.** Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors, and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from the start of registration time on Friday until the end of the regatta unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chair. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.
- **10.2.** Once a team has qualified for a National Championship, members of that team shall not sail at the site to be used for the event, unless that site is their School's home waters or there is a previously scheduled ISSA regatta. Violation of this condition may be cause for disqualification of the team from the event.

# 11. PRIZES:

- **11.1.** Prizes will be awarded to schools placing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in the regatta. The top school will have its name engraved on the perpetual Mallory trophy.
- **11.2.** Trophies will also be awarded to first place skipper and crew in A and B divisions.
- 12. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS: By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

**13. WAIVER OF LIABILITY:** Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
