

2022 Foundry Spring 2 Regatta Saturday, May 14th Historic Coast Guard Station Cleveland, OH 44113

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and will be run in accordance with the Interscholastic Sailing Association Procedural Rules, MISSA District Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILTY:

- 2.1 Competing teams must be members of MISSA in good standing. A "Team" shall be made up of a minimum of 4 sailors, between the grades of 7-12. This is a Tier 3 event. Mixed teams (comprised of students from different schools) WILL be allowed.
- 2.2 The regatta is limited to 18 Varsity Teams and 6 JV teams and entries are accepted on a first come, first served basis. Please have your coach communicate with the regatta chair if you will compete in the Varsity or JV division.
- 2.3 Eligible schools may not enter more than 2 teams.
- 2.4 A JV level regatta may be run simultaneously.
- 2.5 Each team must be accompanied by an adult advisor, parent or coach,

3. BOATS:

- 3.1 420E and C420 boats shall be sailed as provided by The Foundry. Class rules shall not apply.
- 3.2 Boats will be checked in and out upon launch and haul out. Any previously existing damage should be reported upon launching. Any new damage should be reported between races or upon haul out. All damage is the responsibility of the team(s) sailing the boat.
- 3.3 No changes or modifications to rigging or boats are permitted without the permission of the Regatta Chair. Teams violating this rule may be disqualified from the regatta.

4. REGATTA FORMAT:

4.1 This will be a two-division regatta with rotations.

5. ENTRY:

- 5.1 The entry fee is \$20 per sailor. Breakfast and lunch will be available for registered teams and one coach.
- 5.2 Additional lunches for non-competitors may be purchased for \$5.
- 5.3 Registration deadline is 1700 May 12th. Please email **foundrysailing@clevelandfoundry.org** your intention to attend this event.

- 5.5 A damage deposit is required in the amount of \$200 per team. Checks should be made out to *the Cleveland Foundry* and brought to the event.
- 5.6 Foundry waivers for each sailor must be completed as part of online registration or turned in prior to going out on the water.

6. RACING AREA:

6.1 Races will be sailed in the Cleveland Harbor.

7. SCORING:

7.1 The regatta will be scored using ISSA Procedural Rules.

8. PROTESTS:

- 8.1 Competitors protesting a boat shall comply with ISSA PR 16.
- 8.2 Three minute justice will be used for hearing of protests
- 8.3 A competitor shall not communicate with anyone other than teammates or other competitors before reporting to the RC an intention to file a protest. Breaking this rule may be grounds for closing a hearing. This changes RRS 61.

9. COACHING:

9.1 Coaches may not go afloat unless with the permission of the regatta chair or principal race officer.

10. COURSES:

10.1 Based on the conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

11. SAFETY:

- 11.1 Personal flotation devices must be work in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rule 2.2
- 11.2 Drysuits/Wetsuits are strongly encouraged to be worn.

12. SCHEDULE: Saturday, May 14th

0800 - Sailor Check in

0800 - 0900 - Rigging of boats

0900 - Competitors meeting mandatory for all sailors

0930 - First Warning. Races will continue throughout the day.

1500 - No "A" division warning will begin after 1500

Awards following racing

13. DISCLAIMER:

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, or after the regatta.

14. AWARDS:

14.1 Awards will be presented to the top 3 in A & B and Overall teams in the regatta.
