NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the <u>ISSA Procedural Rules</u>, and the <u>ISSA National Championship General Conditions</u> and <u>the Scholastic Dinghy Class Rules</u>.
- 1.2. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Interscholastic Sailing Association in conjunction with host Sharon High School.
- **2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The sailing instructions will be posted on Tech Score prior to the report time for the regatta.
- 3. **COMMUNICATION:** The online official notice board will be Tech Score.

4. ELIGIBILITY:

- 4.1. Competing schools and competitors must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.
- 4.2. Selection of competing schools will be by district elimination. The regatta has 10 berths. Allocations are as follows:
 - 4.2.1. Three berths for NESSA Schools
 - 4.2.2. Two berths for MASSA Schools
 - 4.2.3. Two berths for MISSA Schools
 - 4.2.4. One berth to the host school
 - 4.2.5. Two at large berths. Schools/district interest in being considered for an at large berth should email Rob Hurd (<u>RSHurd@hotmail.com</u>) prior to May 16, 2022.
 - 4.2.6. Schools should contact their district directors to find out details on district qualifiers.
- 4.3. Eligible schools and sailors must enter by submitting and official entry form, regatta fees, and damage deposit with the regatta chair by May 16, 2022. If the elimination for your district is to be held after this date, please have the district director contact the regatta chair immediately so arrangements can be made.
- 4.4. Registration form can be found on the ISSA website
- 4.5. Teams unable to compete must notify the regatta chair as soon as possible.
- 4.6. NESSA will reallocate vacant district quotas. The first open allocation will go to the host district. A berth becomes vacant when the qualifying district becomes unable to fill the berth.

5. FEES:

- 5.1. The entry is \$300 per school. This includes lunch on Saturday, and t-shirts for up to 10 people.
- 5.2. A damage deposit of \$500 must be submitted with each entry. This is refundable if the boat and gear are returned undamaged. In the event damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided evenly amongst all the competing teams.

6. BOATS: 420s provided by host. Boats will be sailed as provided.

7. SCHEDULE:

Friday, (May 20)

1500- to 1730 -Registration/check in at venue Practice schedule as provided

Saturday, (May 21

0900 Check in/registration/Rigging of boats

0930 Sailors' meeting. First warning and schedule for the day announced at this time

Sunday, (May 22)

0900 Rigging of boats

- 1000 First Warning and schedule for the day
- 1600 No race will start after this time. Trophy presentation as soon as possible after racing

Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board.

8. RACING AREA: All races will be sailed on Lake Massapoag.

9. TRAVEL AND HOUSING:

- 9.1. Competitors should use either Boston Logan Airport or Providence TF Green Airport.
- 9.2. A list of nearby motels/hotels is provided in Appendix A

10. COACHING:

- **10.1.** Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from the start of registration time on Friday until the end of the regatta unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chair. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.
- **10.2.** Once a team has qualified for a National Championship, members of that team shall not sail at the site to be used for the event, unless that site is their School's home waters or there is a previously scheduled ISSA regatta. Violation of this condition may be cause for disqualification of the team from the event.
- 11. **PRIZES:** Prizes will be awarded to schools placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the regatta.
- 12. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS: By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.
- **13.** WAIVER OF LIABILITY: Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury

to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
