1. RULES:

2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:

2.1 Official notices including changes to sailing instructions will be posted on the official notice board located in Techscore. Changes to the sailing instructions shall be approved by the regatta chair and posted no later than one half hour prior to the first warning signal on the day it will take effect.

3. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

Saturday

Report time- 0830 Competitors Meeting- 0900 First Warning – 0930 There will be no cut off time for racing.

Sunday,

0900 0815-Report time

First Warning will be as soon as possible after boats are rigged.

4500-1600-No race will start after this time, with the exception of any sail off, if needed

Rigging of FJs-0900

First Warning - as soon as reasonably possible after launching.

No Warning Signal after: 1500

- 3.1 Changes to the official schedule will be posted on the official notice board.
- 3.2 The number of races each day will be at the discretion of the regatta chairperson.

4. ROTATIONS:

4.1 Rotations will be made inside the third basin at SSA. DO NOT GO OUTSIDE THE BASIN.

5. FORMAT:

- 5.1 W4 or W5 courses will be sailed
- 5.2 We will attempt to get in a full rotation

6. PROTESTS:

- 6.2 Marks will be orange cylinders. The starting pin will be a yellow cylinder. The finishing pin will be an orange tetrahedron.
