Notice of Race (NOR)

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The ISSA Procedural Rules 2021-2024 available at https://hssailing.org/documents/ISSA-PR-2021-2024.pdf apply.
- 1.3 The MISSA Supplemental Rules available at <u>https://missa.hssailing.org/about/missa-district-rules</u> apply.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 9am, April 27th, 2024

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located on the applicable techscore page.
- 3.2 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors & coaches on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 This event is a MISSA Tier 3 regatta, open to Minnesota and Wisconsin based MISSA teams in good standing.
- 4.2 An entry consists of 4-8 sailors, visible on techscore and their applicable school's team registration.
- 4.3 Teams may enter the event by registering online at https://give.wayzatasailing.org/b/5kA4iN8CxcYsaxW8wH

- 4.4 To be considered an entry in the event, a team shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees by 0900 on April 27th, 2024.
- 4.5 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: 18 teams.
- 4.6 An entry consists of completing the online registration.

5 FEES

- 5.1 Entry fees are as follows: \$40 per team.
- 5.2 Lunch is not included.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1000.
- 6.2 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made 1500.

7 COURSES

7.1 Courses will be set and sailed in accordance to the recommendations set forth in the ISSA Procedural Rules 2021-2024. Any changes will be noted in the Sailing Instructions.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 This event is a 2 division scholastic event.
- 8.2 A minimum of one race in each division is required for a regatta to be scored.
- 8.3 A teams's series score shall be the total of their race scores, in accordance with ISSA PR.

9 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 9.1 Support vessels shall keep clear of the race course and only coach from the SI designated area between races.
- 9.2 Support boats may be supplied upon prior request of the host. Requests made after Wednesday, April 24th may not be accommodated.

10 RISK STATEMENT

10.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
