SAILING INSTRUCTIONS



1 RULES

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

2.1 The online official notice board is located at <https://scores.hssailing.org/s24/mss/>

2.2 On the water & shore, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to coaches on VHF Channel 71

3 CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Changes to a sailing instruction may be made on the water in accordance with RRS 90.2(c) and ISSA PR 7.3 by hailing competitors of the change, flying code flag "L", and relaying the change via VHF to coach and support personnel.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed from the RC committee boat while docked.

5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

5.1 First warning will be 1000

5.2 No warning will be made after 1500

6 COURSES

6.1 Courses will be set and sailed in accordance to the recommendations set forth in the ISSA Procedural Rules 2021-2024. Any changes will be noted in the course diagrams supplement.

6.2 Course diagrams supplement drawings will include the order in which marks are to be passed, and the course designations to be displayed by the RC.

7 MARKS

7.1 The colours of each mark are included in the course diagrams supplement.

8 THE START

8.1 Races will be started under Appendix U

8.2 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the committee boat and the course side of the starting mark.

9 CHANGE OF COURSE

9.1 To maintain a course configuration, or change course length, marks may be moved as necessary, but no mark shall be moved when any boat is on the leg that it terminates. No change of course signals are required. (Changes RRS 33)

10 THE FINISH

10.1 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the committee boat and the course side of the finishing mark.

11 PROTESTS

11.1 Written protests and requests for redress shall be emailed within the appropriate time limit to 'office@wayzatasailing.org' with the subject line "PROTEST". Failure of the OA to receive written protests by email will not be grounds for redress.

11.2 The protest time limit is 60 minutes after the final warning of the rotation in which the protest occurs.

12 RISK STATEMENT

12.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
