1. Parking

- **1.1** Please do not park in the small lot behind the club in front of the sailing deck. There is ample, free public parking surrounding the club and near each of the spectator areas.
- 1.2 Pick up and drop off works best in front of the club, while entering and exiting through the side access gates.

2. Sailing and Spectator Areas

- 2.1 Racing areas will be dictated by wind and sea conditions. Areas are announced at competitors meetings immediately before the days races. Areas may change during the day due to conditions and are chosen with regard to the quality of racing and safety.
- 2.2 There is abundant free public parking in the zones noted in green. To walk from the Rotation B location to the club is about ten minutes. The seawall is built like an amphitheater. It is recommended to bring a chair for spectating from any of the shore side areas.

3. Club Access

- **3.1** Restrooms are available on the pool deck for those who need a quick break. Locker rooms are accessible from an outside door on the pool deck and then down the hallway, left side entrances.
- **3.2** The lower and upper dining rooms are club areas. No swim wear, hats, or wet clothes should be worn in the club. Shoes and shirts with collars are required. Please do not use the lower dining area as a shortcut from the back of the club to the front.
- 3.3 The pool deck and upstairs outdoor deck is not open unless the regatta event has designated it available.
- **3.4** The sailing deck is always open to competitors and spectators.

4. Food and Beverage Service

4.1 Adult chaperons and parents are welcome to order food and beverages from the club when attending sanctioned events. If you are not a member, please stop by the front desk and register as a weekend temporary member with a credit card authorization.

5. Locker Rooms

5.1 CCYC has limited space in the locker rooms. We ask that competitors not use the locker rooms for storing gear. Please be respectful of our members, who are "opening their home" to visitors. Please limit time spent to a minimum and keep the locker rooms clean.

6. Accommodations

6.1 There are a number of hotels in the downtown area to suit most every budget. Most of them are a five to ten minute walk from the club. Restaurants are plentiful in the downtown area. Most everything a sailor needs is in easy walking distance.
