Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions have been posted on Techscore. Paper copies will not be available on site. ***Please note a schedule change in the Sailing Instructions which differs from the Notice of Series.

Parking

Free street parking is available along Hall St and Marina Way South. Cars entering the launch ramp parking area will be charged \$17/vehicle.

Site info/rigging

Sailors will look for a gray tent in the rigging area (red outlined area) to check in. They need to tell the check in desk their team name and number (if applicable) and their sail number. Sailors may not launch boats until after the competitor's meeting. This is a public launch ramp with many other users and we may not take up space for longer than necessary. Dollies MUST be returned to the rigging area after launching.

Saturday FJ storage

FJs on dollies may be stored overnight in the red outlined area on the map above. Trailers (empty or full) are to be

stored in the yellow outlined area on the opposite side of the parking area.

Coach Boat Storage

For overnight coach boat storage in the water, please call MBYH. The rate to rent a slip is \$1/foot with a minimum of \$24. Coach boats may not be left in the water overnight without renting a guest slip from MBYH.

Spectating

Spectating will be possible along the Bay Trail which goes around the harbor. Please be aware that the Bay Trail has many users including cyclists and we cannot impede access to the trail with chairs or tents. Tents may not be set up on paved surfaces outside of the rigging area.

There is a small grass park at the end of the harbor along the Bay Trail which would provide excellent viewing.

Food

The regatta is not providing food. All sailors are advised to bring their own lunch as well as a reusable water bottle. Parents are encouraged to check out the many great restaurant options in the Marina Bay area.
