SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028*, the <u>ISSA Procedural Rules</u>, the ISSA Code of Conduct, the ISSA National Championship General Conditions and the Scholastic Dinghy Class Rules.
- 1.2. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Interscholastic Sailing Association in conjunction with NESSA and Connecticut College.
- 1.3. Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, as modified by ISSA Procedural Rule 13(c) will be in effect.

2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:

- 2.1. Official notices will be posted on the official notice board located on Tech Score.
- 2.2. Changes to the sailing instructions shall be approved by the protest committee and the ISSA Representative and posted no later than one half hour prior to the first warning signal on the day it will take effect.
- 3. **CODE OF CONDUCT**: [DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with reasonable requests from race officials.

4. SCHEDULE:

4.1. Saturday, May 31, 2025

0900-Check in/registration/Rigging of boats 0930-Sailors' meeting. First warning will be announced at this time

Sunday, June 1, 2025

0900-Check in/Rigging of boats

0915-Sailors' meeting. First warning will be announced at this time

1530-No race will start after this time. Trophy presentation as soon as possible after racing.

- 4.2. The number of races each day will be at the discretion of the regatta chair.
- 4.3. Rotation schedules and boat assignments will be posted on Tech Score before the sailor's meeting.

5. BOATS:

- **5.1.** A-Division will start in FJs
- **5.2.** B-Division will start in 420s
- **5.3.** The fleets will switch as close to midway through the regatta as possible at the discretion of the event chair and PRO.

6. COURSES AND MARKS:

- 6.1. Courses will be in accordance with ISSA PR 7.8
- 6.2. The race committee may designate course selection orally.
- 6.3. The starting pin will be a white ball
- 6.4. All other marks will be orange balls.

7. START/FINISH AND SIGNALS:

- 7.1. Races will start in accordance with ISSA PR 7.9.
- 7.2. The start/finish line will be between a red flag on the race committee boat and a mark.

8. BREAKDOWNS:

- 8.1. Breakdown requests shall be filed in the same manner as protests.
- 8.2. Breakdowns shall be scored in accordance with ISSA PR 9(e). Compensation shall be consistent with ISSA PR Appendix 3.

9. PROTESTS:

- 9.1. Protests procedure will be in accordance with ISSA PR Part VI
- 9.2. RRS 60.4(a)(2) is changed as follows: "(2) if it alleges a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 and is from a boat that was not involved in, and did not see, the incident, or"
- 9.3. Protest Time Limit: The protest time limit for filing a protest or request for redress shall be 20 Minutes after the Race Committee boat has docked following the last race of the day.
- 10. **SCORING:** Scoring will be in accordance with ISSA PR 9.
- 11. **SAFETY:** A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee either before leaving the course, or if that is impossible, immediately after arriving ashore.
