NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the <u>ISSA Procedural Rules</u> and the <u>ISSA National Championship General Conditions</u> and the <u>Scholastic Dinghy Class Rules</u>.
- 1.2. In accordance with RRS 70.3(b), decisions of the protest committee are final. US SAILING's permission has been granted.
- 1.3. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the New England Sailing Association (NESSA) in conjunction with the hosts.
- 1.4. Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, as modified by ISSA Procedural Rule 13(c) may be in effect at the discretion of the race committee.
- 2. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The sailing instructions will be posted on Tech Score prior to the report time for the regatta.
- 3. **COMMUNICATION:** The online official notice board will be Tech Score.

4. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY PROCEDURES, & FEES

- 4.1. Schools qualified to attend through qualifying regattas held May 11th.
- 4.2. See NESSA PR Article K, section 2(c) for more eligibility requirements
- 4.3. There is NO entry fee

5. SCHEDULE:

- 5.1. 0930 Report time/rigging of boats
- 5.2. 0945 Sailor's meeting (First warning announced at Sailor's Meeting)
- 5.3. 1600 No first warning for any A Division race may start after this time, except if the regatta is not official yet, in accordance with the ISSA PR, in which case racing can continue until the regatta is official.

Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board.

6. **RACING AREA:** The Race area will be defined at registration.

7. COACHING:

7.1. Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from the time they arrive at the regatta site until the regatta is done unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chair. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

- 7.2. A coach who is also acting as a Race Committee is exempt from 8.1 between sets of races.
- 7.3. ISSA PR 8 defines other coaching limitations and obligations.

8. **PRIZES:**

- 8.1. Prizes will be awarded to schools placing 1st, 2nd, & 3rd in the regatta.
- 8.2. The top school will get the Rebecca Herreshoff trophy until next year's regatta under the provisions of NESSA PR Article M.
- 9. **RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS:** ISSA PR 5 shall apply.
- 10. WAIVER OF LIABILITY: Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
