**NOTICE OF RACE**



**1. RULES**

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, including the ISSA Procedural Rules.
- 1.2. In accordance with RRS 70.3(b), decisions of the protest committee are final. US SAILING's permission has been granted.

**2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions will be available on the official notice board by 0800 04/19/2025.

**3. COMMUNICATION**

**4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 4.1. The regatta is open to NESSA and non-NESSA teams (conglomerate teams or out of district school teams).
- 4.2. Competitors must be accompanied by a designated adult chaperone, who may be an advisor, coach, or parent.
- 4.3. A maximum of 15 visiting teams will be accepted on a first come first serve basis.
- 4.4. Each team shall consist of at least four sailors, two skippers and two crews, all of whom shall be female.
- 4.5. Schools may enter multiple teams. However if the event is oversubscribed, all schools will be allowed one team before a second team from a school will be accepted.
- 4.6. Eligible teams can enter by completing the online entry form beginning April 7<sup>th</sup> at 0900, but no later than April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025. Entry Form: <https://forms.gle/o9kq2gPiQtGXP7ddA>

Scoring will be in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rule 9.

**9. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
