SAILING INSTRUCTIONS



1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, including the ISSA Procedural Rules.
- 1.2 In accordance with ISSA Procedural Rule 18(a), the right of appeal is denied. Decisions by the Protest Committee shall be final.
- 1.3 RRS 70.3(a) applies.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on line on the Tech Score website..

3. COMPETITORS' MEETING

[NP] Mandatory attendance is required at the competitors' meeting on Saturday 04/26/2025 at 0945. A coaches' meeting will immediately follow the competitors' meeting.

4. CHANGES IN THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change in the Sailing Instructions will be posted before 1100 on the day it will take effect, except that any change in the schedule of races will be posted by 1800 on the day before it will take effect

5. FORMAT

- 5.1 C420's will be divided into two divisions, A and B.
- 5.2 It is the intent of the race committee (RC) to run a single round robin rotation for both fleets. If time, wind, weather or other contingencies make the completion of scheduled round robin impractical, the regatta may be terminated and the results will be based on the current standings.

6. RACING AREA

The racing area will be in Sippican Inner Harbor near Tabor Academy.

7. MARKS

- 7.1 The start and finish marks will be dan buoys with yellow flags.
- 7.2 Marks 1 & 1a will be green spheres.
- 7.3 Marks 2s & 2p will be dan buoys with orange flags.

8. COURSES

- 8.1 Courses will be in accordance with ISSA PR 7.8.
- 8.2 No later than the warning signal, the RC signal boat will announce the course to be sailed.

9. START/FINISH and Signals

- 9.1 Starting Procedure - Races will start in accordance with ISSA PR 7.9.
- 9.2 The start/finish line will be between a staff with an orange flag on the RC signal boat at the starboard end and the course side of the nearby starting/finishing mark.
- 9.3 This changes RRS Appendix U4.

11. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 11.1 Regarding notifications for a protest, attention is brought to ISSA Procedural Rules 15a and 15b.
- 11.2 Protests and requests for redress shall be written on forms available onshore and returned there no later than thirty (30) minutes after the last boat has finished following the race in which the incident occurred. This constitutes the time limit described in RRS 60.3.
- 11.3 The protest committee will hear protests as soon as possible and in the order it determines.

12. SCORING

- 12.1 Scoring will be in accordance with the ISSA Procedural Rule 9.
- 12.2 Three (3) races for each division will constitute a series.
- 12.3 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores
