### SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. RULES:**
  - 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the [ISSA Procedural Rules](#) and [the Scholastic Dinghy Class Rules](#). If there is a conflict between the NOR, any NOR amendment and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence.
  - 1.2. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the MASSA District in conjunction with the MDISA League and Annapolis Yacht Club.
  - 1.3. In accordance with RRS 70.5(a), decisions of the protest committee are final, and US Sailing permission has been granted.
  - 1.4. Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, as modified by ISSA Procedural Rule 14(c) will be in effect.
  - 1.5. Rule 60.4(a)(2) is changed as follows: “(2) if it alleges a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 and is from a boat that was not involved in, and did not see, the incident”
- 2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:**
  - 2.1. Official notices will be posted on the official notice board located on Tech Score.
  - 2.2. Changes to the sailing instructions shall be approved by the protest committee and the ISSA Representative and posted no later than one half hour prior to the first warning signal on the day it will take effect.
- 3. CODE OF CONDUCT:**
  - 3.1 Both the ISSA Code of Conduct (ISSA PR Appendix 1) and the MASSA Code of Conduct will apply to all sailors, coaches, parents and spectators participating and attending our event.

- 4. SCHEDULE:**
  - 4.1. Report times each day are listed in the NOR and are subject to change.
  - 4.2. The number of races each day will be at the discretion of the regatta chair.
  - 4.3. Rotation schedules and boat assignments will be posted on TechScore after the skipper's meeting.
  
- 5. COURSES AND MARKS:**
  - 5.1. Courses will be in accordance with ISSA PR 7.8.
  - 5.2. The race committee may designate course selection orally.
  - 5.3. All marks will be either red, orange, or yellow inflatable marks.
  
- 6. START/FINISH AND SIGNALS:**
  - 6.1. Races will start in accordance with ISSA PR 7.9.
  - 6.2. The start/finish line will be between a flag on the race committee boat and a mark.
  
- 7. BREAKDOWNS:**
  - 7.1. Breakdown requests shall be filed in the same manner as protests.
  - 7.2. Breakdowns shall be scored in accordance with ISSA PR 9(e). Compensation shall be consistent with ISSA PR Appendix 3.
  
- 8. PROTESTS:**
  - 8.1. Protests procedure will be in accordance with ISSA PR Part VI.
  
- 9. SCORING:**
  - 9.1. Scoring will be in accordance with ISSA PR 9.
  
- 10. SAFETY:**
  - 10.1. A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee either before leaving the course, or if that is impossible, immediately after arriving ashore.
  
- 11. COACHING:**
  - 11.1. Coaching will be in accordance with MASSA District Supplemental Rule 6.12.2 Coaching Between Sets: Competitors may receive coaching, including instruction, assistance, equipment or sustenance, only between sets on the dock or on shore unless otherwise directed by the regatta chairperson. This changes ISSA PR 8(a).
