

## St. George's Venue Map/Instructions

All coaching, rotating, and spectating will be held off of Ft. Adam's State Park(80 Fort Adams Dr, see Aerial Map 1,location A). Please plan to park vans at the north end of the fort's parking lot. The race course will be set in close proximity to Ft. Adams(see Aerial Map 1,location B). The Fort visitor's center has a public bathroom that should be open. Otherwise, the spectating area is entirely outdoors. The Park Director has asked that teams NOT USE the visitor's bathrooms for changing and should not store gear bags inside the building. Teams have been asked to spectate and keep their gear on the patio across the road from the visitor's center, along the sea wall, or on the rotation docks. There is a water refill station at the north end of the visitor's center AND another refill station at Sail Newport. Ft. Adams State Park is a carry-in carry-out property, please bring trash bags so that you can manage your team's trash. Our ability to host regattas at this incredible site is heavily dependent on our group's ability to be respectful guest at this state park

### President's Trophy Notes

The boats will be stored at Ida Lewis Yacht Club(see Aerial Map 1,location C) across the harbor. Following the competitor's meeting sailors will be shuttled by water to ILYC to rig their boats for the first flight. Following racing each day, the final flight's teams will return the boats to ILYC to derig and then will be shuttled back to Ft. Adams to meet their teams

When returning to ILYC docks, please enter the basin one-by-one and stay in the middle of the channel between the rocks to the north and the dock pilings to the south(See Aerial Map 2). The boats are stored sequentially with lower numbers to the right as you view the docks from the water.

When derigging, mainsails should be rolled onto the boom with outhaul loosened and tied securely with the mainsheet. Jibs should be rolled and placed on the floor of the boat with the jib sheets still run through the blocks. Tank plugs should be removed, rudders can be placed in the transom and forestays should be lightly tensioned. Boats should be pulled up onto the cradles so that the tie-down lines can run aft of the shrouds

### Terk Trophy

The boats will be stored Sail Newport(see Aerial Map 1,location D) on docks. Following the competitor's meeting sailors can walk to these docks or be shuttled by coaches to rig their boats for the first flight. Following racing each day, the final flight's teams will return the boats to Sail Newport to derig and then may walk or be shuttled back to Ft. Adams.
