



## NYISA-SE Larchmont Intersectional Regatta

### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the [ISSA Procedural Rules](#) and [the Scholastic Dinghy Class Rules](#).
- 1.2. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the MASSA District, in conjunction with Larchmont Yacht Club.
- 1.3. Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, as modified by ISSA Procedural Rule 14(c) will be in effect.
- 1.4. In accordance with RRS 70.5(a), decisions of the protest committee are final, and US Sailing permission has been granted.
- 1.5. RRS D2.1(b) applies. A boat that protests under a rule listed in rule D2.2 or D2.3 for an incident while racing shall hail 'Protest' and display a red flag and is not entitled to a hearing. This changes rules 60.2(a)(1) and 63.2(a).

2. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The sailing instructions will be posted on Tech Score prior to the report time for the regatta.

3. **COMMUNICATION:** The online official notice board will be Tech Score. The on-site Official Notice Board will be announced at the Skippers Meeting.

#### 4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. Competing schools and competitors must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.
- 4.2. The regatta has 18 berths. Allocations will be 10 berths for MASSA and 8 berths for non-MASSA teams. Berths not filled by the deadline will be reallocated by the MASSA District Director.
- 4.3. Eligible schools must enter by emailing Dr. Randall Nunn at [massadistrict@gmail.com](mailto:massadistrict@gmail.com) by 5pm on Saturday, March 21st.
- 4.4. Teams unable to compete must notify the MASSA District Director as soon as possible.

5. **FEES:** There will be no entry fee.

6. **BOATS:** 18 Z420s will be provided by Larchmont Yacht Club.

0900 hrs- Competitors' Meeting

First Warning - As soon as possible after competitors' meeting

**Sunday, March 29, 2026**

SUNDAY IS RESERVED AS A WEATHER DATE ONLY. SUNDAY WILL ONLY BE UTILIZED IF MASSA AND LYC OFFICIALS MAKE A WEATHER DETERMINATION BY 5 PM ON THURSDAY, MARCH 26. THIS IS A ONE DAY EVENT.

Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board.

**8. RACING AREA:** All races will be sailed in the Larchmont Yacht Club harbor.

**9. COACHING AND VENUE RESTRICTIONS:** Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from Friday, March 27 until the end of the regatta unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chair. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

**10. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS:** By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

**11. WAIVER OF LIABILITY:** Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
