Tier 2 Regatta, Fall PCISA Girls Invitational Qualifier

1. Rules:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028, the prescriptions of US Sailing, ISSA Procedural Rules, SEISA District rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 In accordance with US Sailing prescriptions to RRS 70.3(b) and ISSA PR 18, the decisions of the protest committee are final.
- 1.3 Rule 60.4(a)(2) is changed as follows: "(2) if it alleges a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 and is from a boat that was not involved in, and did not see, the incident, or"
- 1.4 Changes to PR 15 (b) "A protesting boat shall, at the first reasonable opportunity after finishing, notify the Race Committee of its intent to protest. Failure to do so makes her protest invalid. This changes rule 60.4."
- 1.5 In the event of a conflict between the governing documents, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence.
- 1.6 The organizing authority is SEISA in conjunction with Corpus Christi Yacht Club.
- 1.7 This regatta is a qualifier for the 2026 PCISA Girls National Invitational regatta in October. To qualify, a school must enter at least two boats. The qualifying team will have the lowest combined score of their two best finishing boats.

2. Eligibility:

- 2.1 Only SEISA teams in good standing are eligible to compete. Competing schools must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in Procedural Rules Part III.
- 2.2 Girls in 8th-12th grade are eligible to participate in this regatta.
- 2.3 Schools may enter multiple boats in this regatta. All teams are required to have a designated coach for safety and boat rotations.

3. Entry and Communications:

- 3.1 Teams can enter by completing the online [Entry Form](#) by 2330, March 16th.
- 3.2 Each school may enter multiple boats comprised of two to four competitors.
- 3.3 Each team must complete and e-sign the Waiver Form to complete registration. Incomplete or missing forms will result in the respective team/school being excluded from the regatta.
- 3.4 Entered teams unable to compete must notify the Regatta Chairperson and their SEISA representative as soon as possible. All entry fees are final and nonrefundable after 2330 on Friday, March 16th, 2026. Registrations are not transferable between teams.



4. Entry Fee

- 4.1 There is no entry fee, this is a SEISA sponsored regatta.
- 4.2 Optional semi-formal buffet dinner in the Library room Saturday night for \$25 per person. The menu is surf and turf with all the extras. Sailors, parents and coaches are welcome, please purchase meal tickets with your boat entry, or at the front desk during the event. Member charge or credit cards are accepted for payment.

5. Damage Deposits

- 5.1 A damage deposit of (\$250.00) **per boat** is required. The refundable boat damage deposit may be submitted via mail before the regatta, or in cash or check at regatta registration. Checks should be made payable to Corpus Christi Yacht Club. Schools that fail to do so will not compete. The deposit is refundable provided all equipment and boats are returned undamaged. In the event of boat damage that can not be attributed to a specific team, the cost of repairs will be shared equally by all teams via their damage deposits.

6. Boats

- 6.1 21 C420s will be provided by Corpus Christi Yacht Club. Boats will be sailed as provided. Competitors may attach telltales to shrouds.
- 6.2 Dock space is available for visiting team coach boats.

7.2 Rotations may take place from a coach boat as designated by the OA. A coach or other support personnel affiliated with the team **must** be present to assist with rotations.

13.2 The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host organization, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
